



Dear Coaches and Team Managers,

Thank you for choosing to participate in the 2010 Kansas City Cup. We are excited with the numbers of teams entered and looking forward to a great event. Please read this document fully and carefully as it contains very important information and **share it with your team members' families.**

1. Brackets have been posted on our website www.raytownsoccerclub.org
2. Schedules will be posted on or before April 23, 2010 4 PM.
3. Changes may be made to correct errors in the schedules- **any changes will be highlighted and noted as updated on your web-based schedules.** Please review your schedules through out the weekend leading up to the tournament. Schedules will be deemed final Monday April 26, 12 noon. Any conflicts with your schedule need to be send to me by Sunday evening April 25, at 5 PM
4. We do charge a **\$5 weekend fee** for parking. Please share this with your team members.
5. *****For KC Metro area teams: Check in will be Thursday April 29, 2010, at our club's office -- 6029 Raytown Road. Raytown, MO 64133 from 6 to 8 PM.** Two free parking passes are issued to each team. For KC Metro area teams those are distributed at check in. If you do not check in on Thursday night you will not get your free parking passes. You can also check in during the week at our office by arranging with our office manager, Lori. Please call in advance (816-313-7721) to set a time.
6. **For teams traveling from outside the KC Metro area, Check in will be 25 minutes before your fist game at the tournament tent located in the center of the complex.** Your parking passes will be mailed to the address listed on the team application.
7. **Items required at check-in:**
 - 1 Copy of your state roster for us to keep
 - 2 Signed and laminated player cards-** in same order as your state roster
 - 3 Notarized medical waivers**in same order as your state roster
 - 4 Guest player forms completed with all signatures required on form
 - 5 For teams not registered with Missouri Youth Soccer Association- Travel Permit from your State Soccer Association.

Just a few other notes, **WE DO NOT ALLOW Pets at the complex** due to liability issues. We have a certified Trainer at the complex during all games. The trainer can be found at the tournament tent throughout the event. We do not supply bleachers so bring chairs to the tournaments.

Awards Ceremonies are held at the tournament tent following the finals.
