#### Assistant Coach & Camp Director - Chad Edwards

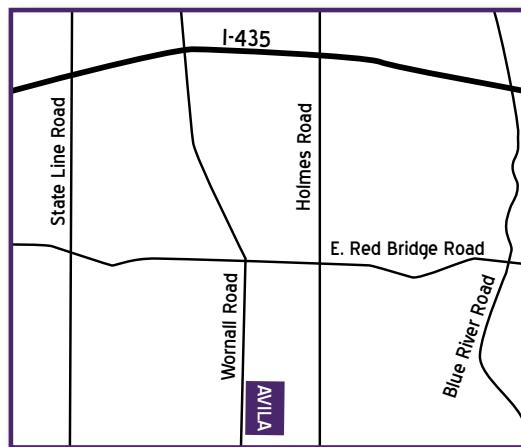

### Day Camps - June 28th - July 1st

The Avila Elite Soccer Camps provides boys and girls, ages 7-13, an opportunity to receive four full days of high level soccer instruction in a fun, rewarding environment.

The most important coaching objective is to combine fun with quality teaching. Camp will focus on development of the player's technical ability. Topics covered will include dribbling, passing, receiving, and shooting. On-field coaches will help develop a better understanding of tactical play through small-sided games. Fun activities will also be included as the part of the daily routine.

All levels of players will be challenged to improve their play. Each camper will be evaluated and placed with players of similar age and ability. Campers will be provided with lunch every day.



### High School Residential Camps Boys - July 25th - July 27th Girls - August 5th - 7th

High School camps will allow players to train in a demanding, college type environment with focus on increasing speed of play and overall tactical knowledge. This camp is for the committed player that is looking to take their game to the next level and challenge themselves against other high level players.

A College Search Forum will be conducted that allows players to have a better understanding of recruiting, the demands of being a student-athlete, and the differences between various levels of play. Peer talks between current Avila players and campers will be held to answer any questions campers may have.

### Goalkeeper Training - All Sessions

Goalkeeper training will be an important feature and emphasis of our camps. Keepers will train separately from field players and then be involved in small-sided and full field games each day. Our goal keeping staff will cover the technical, tactical, physical, and mental aspects of the position.
